## ADMINISTRATION SERVICES

### 1. Information Services

Brothers Touch will regularly update their website as well as posting any major announcements to Facebook and Instagram. The link on our website will redirect members to all draws/results/ladders. Team contacts may also be contacted via txt or phone call.

### 2. Wet Weather

Any cancellations due to wet weather will be posted on our Facebook and Instagram as early as possible as well as on our Facebook page. Emails will also be sent to all team contacts.

### 3. Insurance Cover

The Touch Football Australia Accident Insurance Scheme covers all players and officials who have met the insurance criteria of a TFA affiliated competition. Full details of the cover including claim forms are available on the TFA website <https://touchfootball.com.au/tfa-insurance/> under Resources. Loss of income is not covered. Players are advised to consider the adequacy of the cover and decide whether to take out their own insurance. ALL injuries should be reported to competition admin by filling out an Incident Report Form.

# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## 1. Nominations/Registrations

### a. Team Nomination

If you have a full team of players that you wish to nominate, please nominate the team [here](#).

**Team Nominations and Individual Registrations (For those without a team) close;**

- BOYS                      Friday January 30th
- GIRLS                     Friday February 6th

### b. Individual Registration

**ALL PLAYERS** are to register through the following link;

- If players know the team they are nominating into (with the team contacts permission) they must search their team's name and register into the team
- Players that are not aligned to a team must search 'BROS INDIVIDUALS' and then click the relevant age division. Although we have a high success rate of allocating individuals into teams, there is still a minor chance that we may not be able to due to existing team numbers. If we are unable to allocate a player, a full refund will be given.

**All teams are required to appoint a Parent as a team contact**

**Players can only play in 1 team per Age Division**

We're excited to welcome all boys' and girls' teams to Windsor Park on **Sunday, 15 March** for a fantastic day of touch football. Each division will play **two rounds**, making it a great opportunity for players to compete and enjoy the day together.

Off the field, there'll be plenty happening with **food trucks, music, inflatables and special guests** creating a fun, festival-style atmosphere. We encourage teams and families to bring a blanket and some shade, settle in, and make the most of a great afternoon at the park.

#### 6. Player Sign-On

Referees will be supplied with Team Sheets for every fixture. It is the responsibility of the captain and coach to ensure that the referee ticks off next to the attending player for that match. From Round 4 onwards, any players not registered (On the Sign-On sheet) will not be permitted to play.

## 7. Minimum Number of Player Per Team

Team contacts are to ensure that their team meets their minimum number of players by Round 2.

Age Group	Players On-Field	Recommended Players per Team	Minimum Players per Team
10s	5	9/10	8
12s, 14s, 16s & 18s	6	11/12	9

## 8. Age Requirements/Divisions

Under 10s – born on or after 1 January 2016

Under 12s – born on or after 1 January 2014

Under 14s – born on or after 1 January 2012

Under 16s – born on or after 1 January 2010

Under 18s – born on or after 1 January 2008

***\*If team numbers are limited in a certain age group, Brothers Touch may combine divisions for the purpose of a more substantial competition\* e.g., Girls 16s/18s***

Age groups that we anticipate having a high number of teams will have A and B divisions. Brothers Touch hold the rights to move teams into higher or lower divisions or combine the divisions for the benefit of our competitions.

## 9. Playing Attire

**All Girls and Boys** players/teams must wear the common Brothers Touch Singlet.

The singlet is reversible with Blue and White on one side and Pink and white on the other. According to the fixtures online, the 'Home Team' wears the Blue and White colours for that game and the 'Away Team' wears the pink and white. Singlets are \$50 and able to be purchased on game nights at our playing fields.

## 10. Game Lengths and Time Slots

Games will be 2 x 12-minute halves with a 1-minute half time. Approximate game times are below; Team nominations will most likely make these times vary.

### Monday

- 5:30pm (10s/12s Girls)
- 6:00pm (12s Girls)
- 6:30pm (12s/14s Girls)
- 7:00pm (14s Girls)
- 7:30pm (16s/18s Girls)
- 8:00pm (18s Girls)

## Wednesday

- 5:30pm (10s Boys)
- 6:00pm (12s Boys)
- 6:30pm (14s/16s Boys)

### **11. Game Balls**

Teams are to **supply their own game balls for every round**. Balls can be purchased at the playing fields on game nights.

### **12. Coaching**

All coaches are to remain in the sub box (10 meters either side of halfway) along with your team.

### **13. Eligibility**

To be eligible for finals, a player must be a registered before Round 8.

### **14. Forfeits**

If for any circumstance a team must forfeit, this must be notified to [touch@brothersrugby.com](mailto:touch@brothersrugby.com) or 0423 786 771 at least 24 hours prior to the game.

**Any forfeits after 3pm on game day may incur loss of competition points.**

If a team forfeits for a third time throughout a season, they will be requested to supply reason as to why they should remain in the competition.

### **15. Blood Bin**

Players who are bleeding are to take no further part in a game until the bleeding has stopped and all sign of blood has been cleaned. This also applies to blood on players clothing.

### **16. Non-completion of game**

Should a game not be able to be completed other than by the referee calling it off due to player behaviour i.e., Storm, floodlight, power outage, etc. the following will apply;

- If the stoppage occurs after half of the game has been completed the score at that time will apply and the game will not be replayed

- If the stoppage occurs before halfway through the game, the two teams may record the current score if they agree too (or a draw). Otherwise, the game will be replayed at a mutually acceptable time to both teams and the association.

## **17. Behaviour**

It is the responsibility of each team captain to ensure that both on and off field behaviour of their team members is to a standard expected by Brothers Touch. In the event of any confirmed reports to the contrary and, if such reports are sustained, the Brothers Touch Association will take the strongest possible action against those players. Foul language will not be tolerated both on and off the field.

## **19. Under 10 Modified Rules**

- a. Teams play with 5 on the field. Maximum of 12 can play in any one game
- b. Field size is half (50x35m) of a regular playing field
- c. Acting Half cannot run with the ball
- d. Defence cannot move up until the first receiver has touched the ball
- e. Coaches are allowed on the field for Under 10s **until Round 5 only**

## **20. Photography/Marketing**

At times throughout the competition, Brothers Touch Association may take photos or videos of our members before, during or after games at the given venue.
